#### The EU construction industry ecosystem

- 9.6% of EU Gross Value Added (EUR 1 158 billion)
- 24.9 million jobs, 5.3 million firms
- 35.9% of waste generated, or 2.3 billion tonnes (2018)
- 36% of operational GHG emissions

#### Circularity in construction: ongoing action

#### **Circular Economy Action Plan**

- Waste reduction targets for specific streams and other measures on waste prevention
- Scoping the development of further EU-wide end-of-waste and by-product criteria

#### **Renovation Wave**

- 2050 roadmap to reduce whole life carbon in buildings
- Reviewing material recovery targets and supporting the internal market for secondary raw materials
- Green public procurement criteria
